As provided for by Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, this Interlocal Cooperation Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between Comal County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, and Kendall County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, hereinafter referred to collectively as "Counties" and shall be effective on the date that the signature of the last party is affixed. The Counties have reviewed the Agreement, and each make the following findings:

WHEREAS, Subchapter J, Local Government Code Chapter 351 requires the establishment of a County Adult Sexual Assault Response Team (hereinafter referred to as "Response Teams"); and

WHEREAS, Response Teams are established to strengthen the collaborative response to and enhance health and judicial outcomes for sexual assault survivors who are adults; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Comal County has established an Adult Sexual Response Team (hereinafter "SART") and Kendall County wishes to participate in the services of the SART; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Comal County has previously established a response team with the following minimum members: 1) the chief administrator of a sexual assault program that provides services within the county, or the chief administrator's designee; 2) a prosecutor with jurisdiction over adult sexual assault cases in the county; 3) the sheriff of the county, or the sheriff's designee; 4) the chief of the largest municipal law enforcement agency, if one exists, or the chief's designee; 5) either (A) a sexual assault nurse examiner or forensic examiner that conducts sexual assault forensic exams within the county, or (B) a representative from the largest healthcare provider in the county if there is not a professional described by Paragraph (A); 6) a behavioral health provider within the county, or if one does not exist, a representative from the public health department; and 7) other persons or professionals the counties consider necessary for the operation of the response team; and

WHEREAS, Subchapter J. Local Government Code Section 351.252 allows two or more counties, each with a population of 250,000 or less, within a contiguous area to partner to form a multi-county response team; and

WHEREAS, the inclusion of Kendall County with the SART as a multi-county adult sexual assault response team will most effectively and efficiently fulfill the needs of the citizens of the participating counties to this agreement; and

WHEREAS, participants in the multi-county response team agree to commit to the multi-county response team and assist the response team efforts in accordance with Subchapter J, Local Government Code, Sections 351.253-351.258.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration for the mutual promises given and benefits received, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Term: The term of this Agreement shall be for five (5) years from the date that the signature of the last party is affixed to this Agreement and the term of this Agreement may be extended upon mutual written consent of the Parties. Further, with 30-days written notice of intent, any county may withdraw from this interlocal agreement and the multi-county response team. Upon such withdrawal, the remaining counties will revise the by-laws to form a response team in compliance with statute.
- 2. Amendment: This Agreement may not be amended except in a written instrument specifically referring to this Agreement and signed by the Parties hereto.
- 3. Venue: This interlocal agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, without regard to its conflict of laws principles. Exclusive venue shall be in a court of competent jurisdiction in Comal County, Texas
- 4. Implementation: The Counties participating in the multi-county adult sexual assault response team agree to work together to meet the objectives set forth in the Local Government Code. To implement this interlocal agreement, both Comal County and Kendall County personnel do hereby agree to meet from time to time to implement, review, and update the SART policy and protocols, as necessary to remain in compliance with the requirements of the Local Government Code.
- 5. Notice: Any notice required under the provision of this Agreement shall be in writing and delivered in person, by fax or deposited in the United States Mail, registered or certified, return receipt requested. Any such notice must be addressed to the following addresses. Any notice shall be deemed received three days after the date of deposit in the United States Mail, unless proof is offered to the contrary. Unless otherwise provided in this Agreement, all notices shall be delivered to the following addresses:

Either party may designate a different address by giving the other party written notice.

- 6. Severability: In the event that one or more of the provisions contained in the Agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect by a court of competent jurisdiction, this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein, but shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Agreement, which shall remain in full force and effect.
- 7. Immunity: No provision of this Agreement shall affect or waive any sovereign or governmental immunity available to Comal County and/or its elected officials, officers, employees and agents under Federal or Texas law nor waive any defenses or remedies at law available to Comal County and/or its elected officials, officers, employees and agents under Federal or Texas law.

Accordingly, this Agreement has been duly executed and delivered by both Parties and constitutes a legal, valid and binding obligation of the Parties. Each person executing this Agreement on behalf of each party as signatories below, represents and warrants that they have full right and authority to enter into this Agreement. This Agreement becomes effective when signed by both of the authorized representative for Comal County and Kendall County.



3. SCOPE OF SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY BGE: (If additional pages are necessary, they are identified as Attachment B)

The following Scope of Services is proposed.

Preliminary Engineering Schematic

Upon written Notice to proceed from the County, BGE will commence the Preliminary Engineering Phase. The primary goal of which is to produce a schematic layout and construction cost estimate with the goal to submit the project to the Alamo Area MPO for funding consideration. Detailed tasks are as follows:

- 1. Data Collection: Data collection includes, but is not limited to the following,
 - i. Existing hydrologic and hydraulic models;
 - ii. Available GIS data consisting of existing aerial photography, two-foot topography, road centerlines, and information relating the existing hydrologic and hydraulic models;
 - iii. City of Boerne standards including typical street sections and standard drainage details;
 - iv. As-built plans for the street, and utilities within identified study areas;
 - v. Flooding reports;
 - vi. Adjacent Development plans;
 - vii. Utility block maps and or GIS shapefiles;
 - viii. Conduct one (1) site visits to the site.
- 2. Right of way Surveying and Mapping: The Client will provide an existing right of way base map, topographic survey, and recent plats provided by the City of Boerne.

Professional Service Agreement

- 3. Base Mapping: BGE will develop an existing terrain model utilizing the topographic survey provided by the Client. The topographic survey will be supplemented with existing publicly available Lidar as needed.
- 4. Preliminary Roadway Design: BGE will develop the preliminary design of the roadway horizontal and vertical alignment based on topographic survey, aerial photography, existing right of way, and the provided terrain model. The preliminary roadway design will be displayed on a schematic layout of the project area to include a roadway plan view with aerial background, vertical profile, and proposed and existing roadway typical sections.
 - i. Existing and proposed typical roadway sections will be developed based on the City of Boerne's thoroughfare plan and input from the County and City. The anticipated typical section is to be a two-lane roadway with shoulders, drainage ditches, 10-foot shared use paths on each side of the roadway, and a continuous center turn lane, within a 76-foot right of way.
 - ii. The roadway design will include turn lanes at the intersections with Sofia Circle, Enterprise Parkway, Vallerie Lane, and Corley Road.
 - iii. Right of way acquisition needs will be developed based on the preliminary alignment and proposed typical section. The approximate real estate costs including, but not limited to, property values and easement costs if necessary will be determined based on Kendall County Appraisal District appraised value multiplied by a factor of 1.75 or as determined by the County. The proposed ROW width is anticipated to be 76-feet per the City of Boerne thoroughfare plan. A list identifying the amount of right of way and / or easement per parcel will be provided.
 - iv. Existing easements identified in the survey or through design research will be shown and identified on the schematic layout.
- 5. Preliminary Bridge Design: BGE will develop the preliminary bridge design to improve the existing bridge over Balcones Creek. The bridge will be designed to pass the 25-year flood event. The design will include determining the most economic structure (Box Beam, I-girder, slab beam, or slab span) to use to meet the roadway and drainage requirements. The bridge structure, number of spans, and span lengths will be shown in the plan and profile view of the schematic. The bridge will be designed according to TxDOT Bridge Design criteria.
- 6. Preliminary Drainage Design: BGE will develop the preliminary design of the drainage infrastructure needed for conveying drainage conditions in the project area using criteria set forth in the City of Boerne's Design Criteria Manual. Flood frequencies at the 5-, 10-, 25, and 100-year flood event alternatives will be evaluated and if feasible, with concurrence with County, will be incorporated into the design.
 - i. Drainage structure sizes will be determined for three drainage crossings per City of Boerne design criteria which is designed for the 5-yr event and checked for no over-topping at the 100-yr event.
 - ii. Street drainage will be designed for the 5-yr event with one (1) 12' dry lane.
 - iii. Develop a culvert layout for the existing crossing approximately 1,600 ft. north of Reed Road including culvert sizing, material, headwall type, and flowlines to accommodate the future roadway widening. A cost estimate will be developed utilizing the most recent TxDOT average low-bid unit prices. The culvert layout will be designed to sufficient level to confirm the design developed by others and can be constructed by others. Bid and construction phase services, if required, will be an additional service.

The cost estimate will include appropriate contingencies, typically 30%, and an escalation factor for the anticipated construction date.
