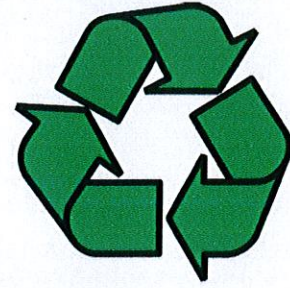


# Kendall County Recycling

## PREPARE YOUR RECYCLABLES:

- Wash or rinse out all containers.
- Remove and discard all bottle caps and pumps.
- Recycle individual items in the appropriate collection bins; do not bag your items.
- Please do not contaminate the collection bins with any food items, hazardous waste or non-recyclable debris.

## ACCEPTED RECYCLABLES:

These are the items that are accepted at this time: aluminum, cardboard, plastic containers with recycling symbol #1, plastic containers with symbol #2, plastic containers with symbol #3 to #7, steel/tin cans.

**Aluminum** - rinsed aluminum cans, clean foil pans and clean aluminum foil.

**Cardboard** – All items must be flattened and cut to a maximum size of three foot square – moving and shipping boxes, cereal boxes, drink cartons, brown paper grocery bags, brown paper feed sacks.



**Plastic #1** – Recycle symbol #1 must appear on the container – Rinsed soda and water bottles with caps removed and any other items marked with the #1 recycling symbol.



**Plastic #2** – Recycle symbol #2 must appear on the container – Rinsed milk and detergent bottles with caps removed and any other items marked with the #2 recycling symbol.

**Plastic #3-7** – Recycle symbol #3-7 must appear on the container - These items can be co-mingled in the same bin. - Rinsed water bottles, yogurt containers, plastic cups and plates, Tupperware and reusable water bottles.

**Steel/Tin Cans** rinse out all steel/tin cans, vegetable or soup cans. Labels can remain on the can.
