JAMES KIEHL RIVER BEND PARK RULES

Park Hours are 7:00 am to Dusk

Swim at your own risk. No lifeguards are provided.

All Texas state boating laws will be enforced.

No jumping from bridges or trees.

No glass or foam containers. No person shall bring into or use glass or foam containers in the park.

No motorized boats.

No excessive noise. Be respectful of other visitors. "Excessive" being a level which disturbs visitors or adjacent residents in the park or on the river.

Minors must be accompanied by an adult

Dogs on leash only. Other animals prohibited. Dogs must be under owner's direct control and attached to a person or fixed object at all times.

No public display of alcoholic beverages

No ground fires, or burning of charcoal or wood. Propane stoves and grills are allowed.

Motorized vehicles are allowed on designated roadway and parking areas only. Vehicles unlicensed for street use are prohibited.

Vehicles left after closing will be towed at owner's expense.

Kendall County is not responsible for damages to or theft of personal property.

No person shall possess or discharge weapons, firearms or fireworks of any kind.

Smoking in designated areas only.

No soliciting. No person may rent or sell any item or service without an approved concession contract.

Metal detectors are prohibited in the park.

No littering. No garbage or other solid waste may be dumped.

Any vehicle, boat, trailer or other property abandoned will be removed and stored at owner's expense. Abandoned property is subject to sale.

Visitors shall remain within designated park boundaries. Trespassers will be prosecuted.

Any violation of park rules may result in immediate removal from the park.
