

**Kendall County Parks Department
Joshua Springs Park and Preserve Rules**

- No swimming.
- All Texas state boating laws will be enforced. No Motorized Boats.
- Fishing in designated area only. No fishing from watercraft.
- No public display of alcoholic beverages.
- Burning of charcoal allowed only at designated sites.
- Smoking in designated areas only.
- No excessive noise.
- No glass containers.
- No rollerblading and skateboarding.
- Horses in designated area only.
- Dogs on leash only.
- No person shall display or discharge weapons, firearms or fireworks of any kind.
- No soliciting without a permit.
- Metal detectors are prohibited in the park.
- No collection or disturbance of natural resources.
- No household garbage or other solid waste may be dumped.
- Kendall County is not responsible for damages or theft of personal property.
- Only licensed motorized vehicles are allowed on designated roadway and parking areas. Vehicles left after closing will be towed at owner's expense.
- Violation of park rules may result in removal from the park.
