

**Kendall County Parks Department
Kreutzberg Canyon Natural Area Rules
Park Hours: 7am to Dusk**

- Abandoned property is subject to sale.
- All Texas state boating laws will be enforced.
- Any vehicle, boat, trailer or other property abandoned will be removed and stored at owner's expense.
- Any violation of park rules may result in immediate removal from the park.
- Avoid posted areas. Sensitive habitats and natural hazards are posted.
- Dogs on leash only. Other animals prohibited. Dogs must be under owner's direct control and attached to a person or fixed object at all times.
- Kendall County is not responsible for damages to or theft of personal property.
- Metal detectors are prohibited in the park.
- Minors must be accompanied by an adult
- Motorized vehicles are allowed on designated roadway and parking areas only. Vehicles unlicensed for street use are prohibited.
- No collection or disturbance of natural resources: wood, rock, plants, or wildlife.
- No excessive noise. Be respectful of other visitors. "Excessive" being a level which disturbs visitors or adjacent residents in the park or on the river.
- No glass or foam containers. No person shall bring into or use glass or foam containers in the park.
- No ground fires or burning of charcoal or wood. Propane stoves and grills are allowed.
- No jumping from bridges or trees.
- No littering. No garbage or other solid waste may be dumped.
- No motorized boats.
- No person shall possess or discharge weapons, firearms or fireworks of any kind.
- No public display of alcoholic beverages
- No soliciting. No person may rent or sell any item or service without an approved concession contract.
- Smoking in designated areas only.
- Swim at your own risk. No lifeguards are provided.
- Vehicles left after closing will be towed at owner's expense.
- Visitors shall remain within designated park boundaries. Trespassers will be prosecuted.
