<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>	<p>The District is to be created and is to operate under Article III, Section 48-e, of the Texas Constitution, as proposed by S.J.R. No. 27, Acts of the 70th Legislature, Regular Session, 1987, and adopted by the voters at an election held November 3, 1987.</p> <p>The proposed ESD No. 1 will serve a large area of over 50 square miles in eastern Kendall County, and a portion of the San Antonio ETJ. The service area covers roughly from Ammann Road on the south to the Guadalupe River on the north and from the Comal County line on the east to Rust Lane on the west.
