ROAD MAINTENANCE WORKER II

GENERAL SUMMARY

Under direct supervision, the purpose of the position is to perform a variety of general road maintenance duties.

EXAMPLES OF ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Duties may include but are not limited to the following:

Perform all duties of a Road Maintenance Worker I

Operates various equipment at a basic level for construction and maintenance projects including backhoes, rubber tired loaders, towable barricades, concrete saw or vibrator, tandem trucks, water trucks, twelve ton trailers, skidsteer with all attachments, truck tailgate spreaders and conveyors, and terrain forklift, reclaimer/recycler, track loader, haul-truck and equipment trailer along with side dump trailer, oil distributor truck, herbicide spray truck with herbicide license only, and Gradall.

Perform basic welding and water gap construction.

Cleans culverts as needed.

Oversees job tasks.

EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING

Formal education that includes addition and subtraction and reading, writing, and speaking common English vocabulary; supplemented by one (1) year previous experience or training that includes road construction, work zone safety, and motorized equipment operation.

LICENSES AND CERTIFICATIONS

Must be able to obtain a valid commercial driver's license with endorsement N.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of:

- Heavy Construction and maintenance equipment.
- Correct English usage and grammar.

Ability to:

- Communicate verbally and in writing so as to allow comprehension by receiving party.
- Understand and exchange information with supervisors and co-workers when receiving assignments and instructions.
- Communicate and interact with public and work crew.
- Follow safe work practices including workplace safety policies and procedures.
- Walk, stand, sit, kneel, push, stoop, crawl, twist, reach above the shoulder, grasp, pull, bend repeatedly, climb stairs and ladders.
- Use heavy and light construction and maintenance equipment and chemicals.
- Operate a motor vehicle.
- Exert heavy physical effort involving objects and materials of 50 pounds to 100 pounds in an outside environment with various weather conditions.
