Joshua Springs Park & Preserve – OPEN

Entry will be at no cost and will be on a first-come first-served basis. Upon reaching park capacity (225 vehicles), the entry gates will be closed to the public until the event concludes. In addition to our restroom facilities, the park will be equipped with extra portable toilets and trash receptacles – please responsibly dispose of your trash in the provided receptacles. We are expecting large crowds with a high volume of traffic on roadways, so anticipate delays upon exiting the park.

Kreutzberg Canyon Natural Area & James Kiehl River Bend Park – CLOSED

Due to the expected mass population influx to Kendall County, and limited resources, gates to Kreutzberg Canyon Natural Area and James Kiehl River Bend Park will be closed on the evening of April 7, 2024 and will be re-opened the morning of April 9, 2024.
