STATEMENT REGARDING COURTROOM SANITATION

The 451st District Court is working hard to keep litigants who are still needing access to the Court, as well as Court personnel, safe. As a result, March 16 through March 31, 2020, the following courtroom sanitation procedures will be in place for all utilizing the 451st District Court:

1. Everyone entering the courtroom will be required to use HAND SANITIZER when they WALK INTO the courtroom.
2. Everyone will wipe the areas they were using with the provided sanitizing wipes before leaving the courtroom.
3. As you leave the courtroom, please take a few more squirts of HAND SANITIZER and an extra sanitizing wipe for the road.

The 451st District Court remains open to hear matters in person, if the litigants desire and agree to abide by the Courtroom Sanitation procedures. However, the Court is offering the following additional options:

1. Telephonic hearings;
2. Hearings by submissions;
3. Video conferencing via Facetime; or
4. Reschedule.
