

Health Protocols for Voters

Voters who exhibit any of the symptoms associated with COVID-19 when they arrive at a polling locations may want to consider utilizing Curbside Voting.

- Voters will see COVID-19 safety signs as they enter the polling locations.
 - o Self-Assessment
 - o Social Distancing
 - o Mask use recommendations- How to wear and take down your mask
 - o How to prevent the spread of COVID19

- Voters should consider wearing their personal cloth face covering when entering the polling place. The voter should be prepared to lower or remove their face covering when checking in at the polling place.

- Voters should consider bringing their own marking instruments such as a pen, pencil with eraser, or stylus to use when checking-in to vote and for marking their ballot.

- Station 1- At the Check-In Table, the Voter will be greeted and advised to sanitize their hands before and after voting.
 - o Voters will maintain at least six feet separation from other individuals at the polling location.
 - o Surfaces of ePollBooks will be cleaned with isopropyl alcohol.
 - o Voter will be issued a Stylus to sign their name on the electronic signature screen and will be instructed to place it in the designated bucket for sanitation and reuse.
 - o Voter will be given their voter specific Activation Card and directed to the next station.

- Station 2 – A Poll Worker will direct the voter to the voting machine.
 - o Voters waiting to be put onto a voting machine will maintain at least six feet apart and stay in the designated areas
 - o All voting equipment will be placed 6 feet apart at all times (where possible).
 - o All used voting equipment will be wiped down after each voter not wearing a mask.
 - o All Voting Stations will be thoroughly wiped down throughout the day.
 - o Voter will use a sanitized pencil (eraser-end down) on the machine to make their selection.
 - o Voter will place used pencil in the designated bucket for sanitation and reuse.

- Sanitation Team – The sanitation team will disinfect any items that come into contact with voters, such as:
 - o Electronic check-in computers
 - o Voting system equipment
 - o Voting Stations
 - o Doors leading into and out of the polling place
 - o Tables/Chairs

All Election Judges and Poll Workers will be supplied and advised to wear gloves and masks throughout the day. All Election Judges and Poll Workers will be instructed on appropriate cleaning and disinfection, hand hygiene, and respiratory etiquette.
