2. At 1:32 p.m. a public hearing was held on the proposed Tax Rate of \$.4127 per \$100 (same rate as last year) for 2020 where all interested parties were invited to attend said hearing and express their views for or against the adoption of the publicized Tax Rate for 2020. No one spoke.

At 1:33 p.m. the public hearing was closed.

COUNTY OF KENDALL It is ordered by the Commissioners' Court of Kendall County, Texas, that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption a 2020 tax rate of \$0.412700, which is effectively a 1.83 percent increase in the tax rate. The 2020 tax rate includes the Debt Service Rate of \$0.052295 and the Maintenance and Operations Rate of \$0.360405 (both rates are per \$100.00 of taxable value).

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 1.29 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$4.60.

COUNTY OF KENDALL It is ordered by the Commissioners' Court of Kendall County, Texas, to adopt the following discounts for early payment of County Property Taxes: 3% discount if paid in October, 2% if paid in November, and 1% if paid in December.
